Written Description

Central Presbyterian Church (aka CENTRALongmont) is proposing to install a new and permanent sign for the corner of 4th and Kimbark. There will be no structural changes made to the building in completing this project. We believe that the large iron pillars and angle iron outline gives the architectural arched top a strong and lasting presence that holds true to the large stone church that has stood the test of time. The color black that we have chosen to go with for the iron frame helps us tie into the original lighting fixtures and banisters of the church and the neighborhood benches and posts. The sign material itself will be a heavy gauge aluminum covered with a skin to be made and designed by a local graphics sign company. The width of the sign proposed is 10 feet from outside pillar to outside pillar. The height of this sign is 6′ 10 5/8″ high from the ground to the center of the arch. The sign has 49.5sq ft of signage with 16sqft that is changeable through the process of manually installing a new 4′ 4″ x 1′ 10″ piece of signage. This sign will be front lit from existing landscape spot sights in the ground.
