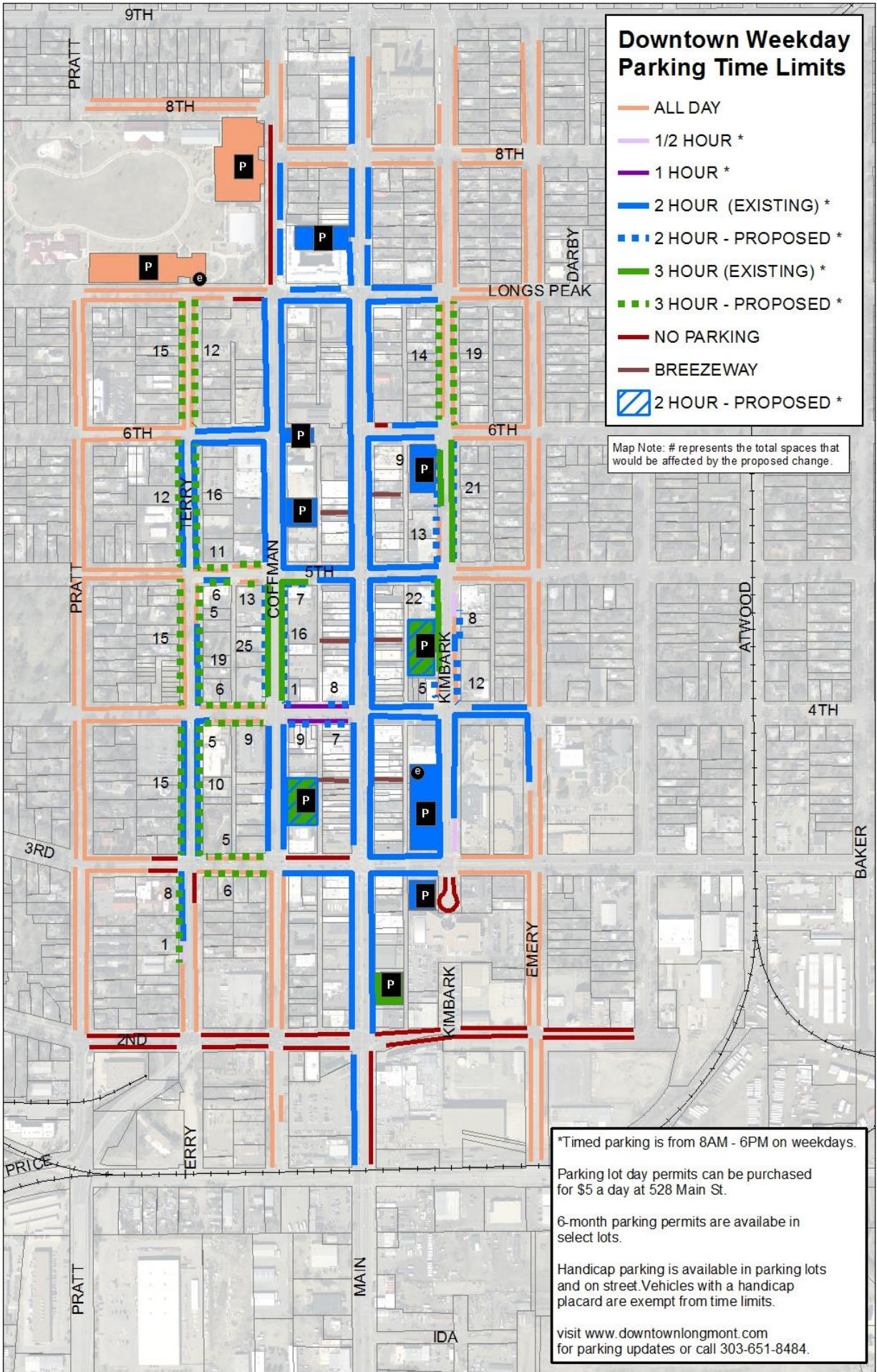

Handicap parking is available in parking lots and on street. Vehicles with a handicap placard are exempt from time limits.
